## THE COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT (CID)

The Commercial Street CID is a political subdivision of the State of Missouri, officially established in 2009, and renewed in 2019 for 15 years. The CID operates with funds generated from a special imposed CID sales tax of .5% and pays for such things as public improvement projects, services that benefit the district, special event support, landscaping, maintaining public spaces, and more. With the special sales tax, our rate is 8.6%, instead of 8.1% that is charged throughout our city. The tax is on sales in store and online.

The Commercial Street Community Improvement District is made up of a volunteer Board of Directors and a part-time staff person. The Board of Directors is composed of business owners, property owners (or representatives), or registered voters living within the district.

## MISSOURI DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE

The DOR is the state department that collects and distributes sales tax collected by all businesses. Before you start collecting revenue, it is imperative that you connect with the DOR to ensure that you are collecting the correct sales tax. (The DOR is supposed to automatically locate you in our district, but it is always good to double check!) The DOR needs the business name, physical address within the district, the business Missouri Tax ID Number, and our Political Subdivision Code (CID00148). You can reach them via email or phone call.
